#### Your Portraits look so REAL!

The realism you see in our artwork is created personally by Jason, who is not only the portrait photographer but also the digital artist of our team. We invest quite literally hours of time into creating your amazing finished gallery so that you have an amazing, almost lifelike, selection of portrait images to choose from.

## How do I book?

We ask for basic contact information, your child's age and your sitting fee to secure your place ( payable within 48 hours of booking ).

Your sitting fee is payable in full at time of booking and is non-refundable if you cancel within 14 days of your portrait shoot, unless we are able to re-fill your place.

All refunded siting fees are subject to a 10% handling charge.

Sitting fees may be paid by card / Paypal or bank transfer.

## My child has additional needs – is the sitting suitable?

We regularly work with children who have additional needs and welcome dialogue with parents prior to the sitting. Our aim is always to create a fun environment and an amazing gallery but of course with your child's comfort and safety always to the fore.

We use flash during the sitting and for the scenes your child will need to be able to follow direction and sit up in a relatively static position. If you'd like to know more and discuss the sitting for your child please pop Lorna a message and we will be more than happy to talk you through the experience.

# Why the minimum age?

MERMAID requires a high degree of direction, confidence and a little acting and, whilst we know some younger children thrive in new environments with new people, in our experience most do not.

Ultimately, we want to create portraits for you that look amazing and do so in a sitting that is lovely, relaxed experience for your child.

The good news is that we plan to return to all our venues over the next couple of years so please get in touch to be on our waiting list and the first to hear when new dates are ready.

## When do we see the finished photos?

Digital Art of this calibre takes many hours of processing to create each gallery and so we invite you to return to your venue ( or one of our other venues if you prefer ) on a different date for a private gallery viewing.

Please note that we only present our work via in-person viewings. Web galleries are not available.

Gallery Viewings may be pre-booked, please ask for dates and venue options.

You are most welcome to bring other family members or friends to your viewing – we usually have seating for up to 10 people. As with the photo shoot, please bring an extra pair of hands if you are joining us with small children as we don't have a dedicated play area and know that you will want to be able to concentrate when choosing your artwork.

### How much will this cost?

We have a fabulous interest free spread payment plan for all our Mermaid art purchases.

Artwork starts at £95 / £10 per month via standing order. (T&Cs apply)

## How long do you keep my gallery?

We retain your finished gallery for 30 days after your viewing day, after which time it is removed from our system unless a deposit payment has been received.
